These are the only supplies that we can accept at this time:

- Unopened N95 respirators & surgical masks
- Unopened packages of disposable gloves
- Unopened containers of hand sanitizer (60+% alcohol based)
- Unopened containers of disinfectants & disinfecting wipes
- Packaged, unused protective goggles
- Unopened swabs for collecting screening samples
- Unopened gowns (surgical & isolation)
- Face shields

New! We will also accept donations of home-made masks. This will help us manage our supplies of medical-grade masks for physicians and staff who provide direct patient care. Home-made masks need to meet certain specifications in order to be effective.
